

Rules and Regulations 2020

- All stalls and gazebo pitches will be allocated as part of the online booking and purchase procedure and must be adhered to.
- Traders are required to provide their own table and display, which must be free standing with no fixings made to the pergolas or stalls. Any damage by individual traders must be paid for immediately. Stalls must allow room for customers to get off the road to view merchandise.
- The Market operates 10.00am - 5.00pm. Traders may arrive to set up from 8.00am and no vehicle may at any time block the road. All vehicles must be cleared from Breageside and the Harbour Head by 9.30am and there is no parking available in the shipyard. Traders are requested not to pack away before the market finishes at 5.00pm.
- Pitches must be thoroughly cleaned at the end of each trading day, with all rubbish and debris removed by traders. Do not use the public litterbins.
- Displays and tables must not intrude into the roadway or overflow into any other space.
- It is the responsibility of all food producers to observe Environmental Hygiene Regulations. Advice is available through Cornwall County Council.
- It is the responsibility of all traders to provide proof of Public Liability Insurance. The Market Manager may request to see this along with your booking receipt.
- When booking, please check dates carefully as all stalls and gazebos must be paid for at the time of booking. No refunds or exchanges are available.
- The Market Manager may cancel bookings with no refund if Porthleven Harbour Market Rules and Regulations are not abided by, or the behaviour of any trader is considered to be anti-social or at risk of bringing the market into disrepute.
- These Rules and Regulations are subject to change.
